How To Install Skoolbag On Your Smartphone

iPhone & iPad Users

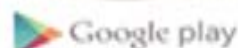
1. Click the "App Store" icon on your Apple device.
2. Type your school name in the search, using suburb name will help.
3. If iPhone, you will see your school appear, click "Free" then "install".
4. If iPad, change the drop list to "iPhone Apps", your school will then be visible, click "Free" then "install".
5. When installed click "Open"
6. Select "OK" to receive push notifications, when asked.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you.



Android Users

You must first have signed up with a Google Account before installing the app.

1. Click the "Play Store" button on your Android Device
2. Click the magnifying glass icon at the top and type in your school name, using suburb name will help.
3. Click the school name when it appears in the search.
4. Click the "Install" button.
5. Click "Accept" for various permissions (please note, we do not modify any of your personal data on your device).
6. Click "Open" when installed.
7. Click the "More" button on the bottom right of the App, then "Setup".
8. Toggle on the Push Categories that are applicable for you.

Changes to Bus Route numbers

Dear Parent/carer,

Transport for NSW is seeking to improve the consistency and accuracy of bus service information across NSW, school bus numbers and names are being standardised.

As a result, school bus numbers and names are being amended and bus services which operate to and from your school will be included in this upgrade.

Please note, there will be no change to school bus routes during this time.

To support your school in informing students and parents of these changes, please find relevant key information and materials attached and listed below:

- Schedule of School Route Service Changes

Detailing old bus numbers, associated new bus numbers and updated bus route names. This has been formatted for printing and distribution to school office.

In supporting the transition to the new bus numbers all bus services will display the current/old bus number next to the new bus number to ensure students and teachers can clearly identify their bus and familiarise themselves with the new bus number.

The current/old bus number will be displayed for a period of one month from the 2nd July 2018 (excluding school holidays).
